Applications for Appointment as a Trustee

Are you interested in promoting Northland's business development potential? The Northland Regional Council is looking for enthusiastic, skilled and committed people to join the other Trustees on its Community Trust. The Northland Regional Council Community Trust which operates under the name "Enterprise Northland", was established in March 1996 and undertakes the role of Northland's regional economic development agency.

Candidates will preferably have:

- proven business management experience
- knowledge of Maori culture and issues relating to business development
- experience in Trust operations or regional business development
- experience and expertise in strategic planning and financial management
- good networking skills and business connections.

Trustees need to be independent in their ability to assist the Northland region, and be free from political and other pressures. By law, applicants must not be employed by, or elected representatives of, any local authority of the Northland region. Trustees must be able to represent the best interests of the whole of the region and its peoples, and reside in Northland.

Trustees may also be appointed to the Trust's subsidiaries, Destination Northland Limited and the Enterprise Northland Trust.
