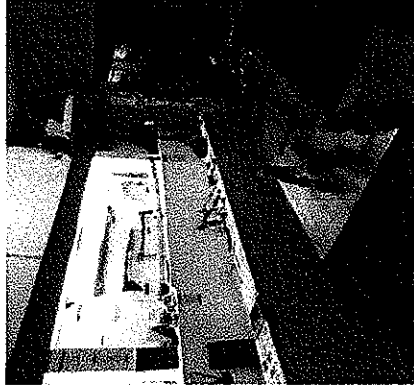
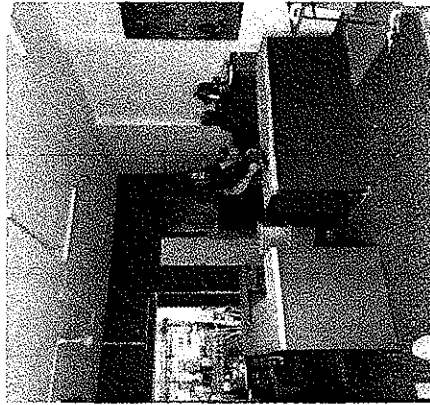
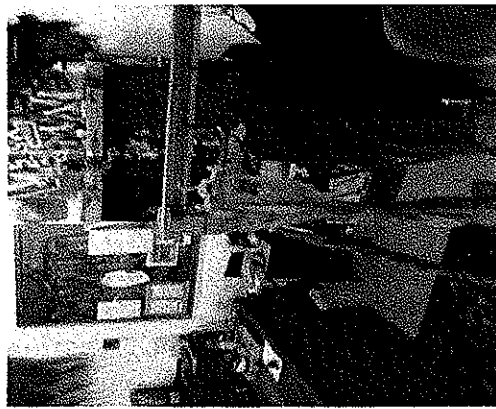
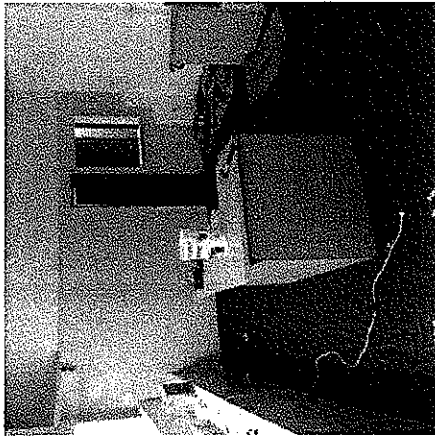
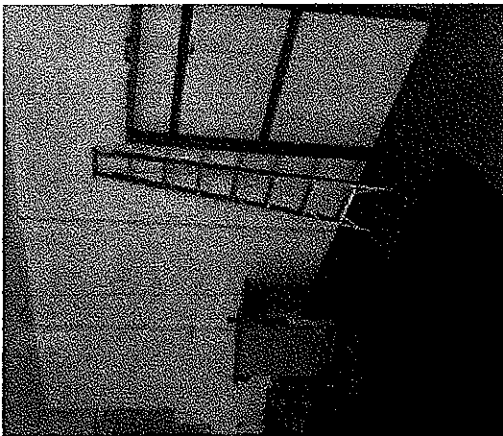


# Legitimate Programme 2009 / 2010



## **Gallery site and Airbrush unit Construction**

68b Gillies Street, Kawakawa

Leased shop-front in December 2009 - venue to complete gallery section of Legitimate Programme. Within the gallery, Legitimate has streamlined the airbrushing process for apparel. Exhibiting works began in April 2010. Shop fitting completed by Head Tutor



### **Moerewa School and Legitimate programme beautification sculpture project**

August 2009 - 10 student hand-picked by Principal of Moerewa School. Objective was to create a sculpture for Moerewa School introducing the students to all elements of sculpting from conception to process and installation. Introduction to public sculpting included as students were also involved in process for Kawakawa Town Gateway sculpture (pics 3 & 4). The installation section of project under completion.



### **Moerewa School Graphic Design Legitimate programme**

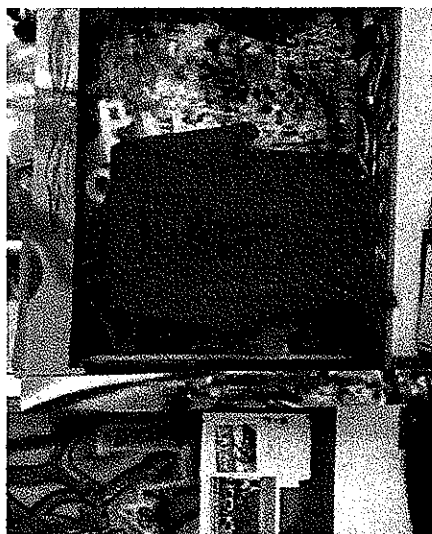
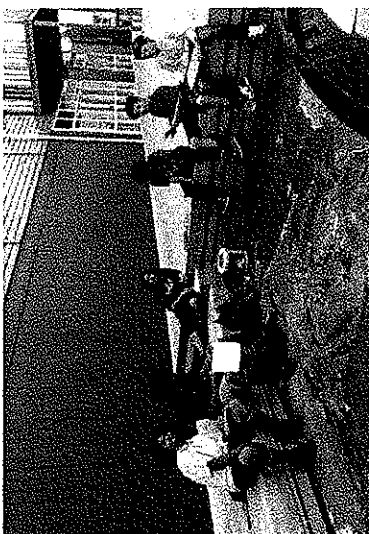
August 2009 – 10 students hand-picked by Moerewa School Principal. Placed through Graphic Design section of Legitimate Programme have successfully produced air-brushed and stencilled clothing labels. Labels include Hyphin-Farno, Ward of the State; Warden In Corp; Tuna Town.





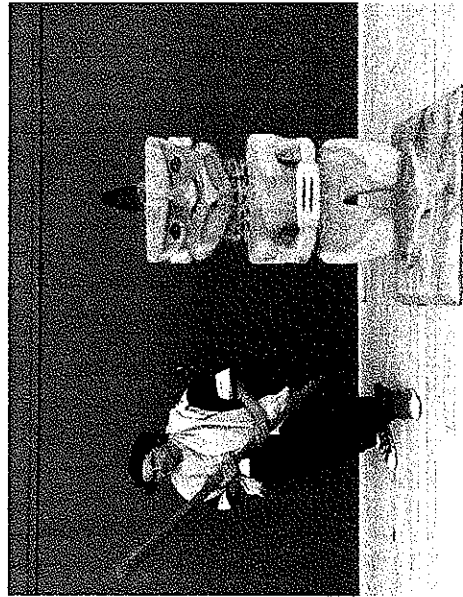
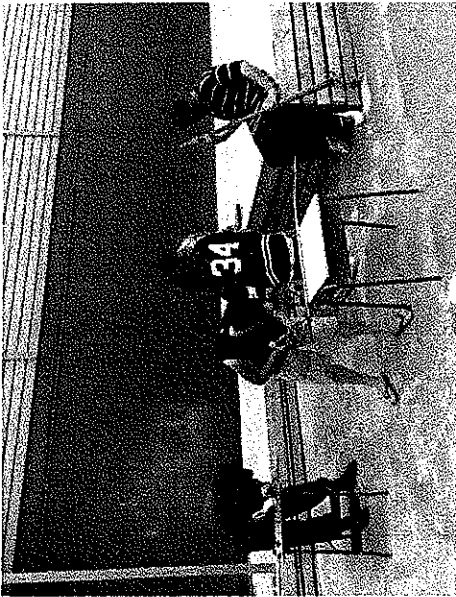
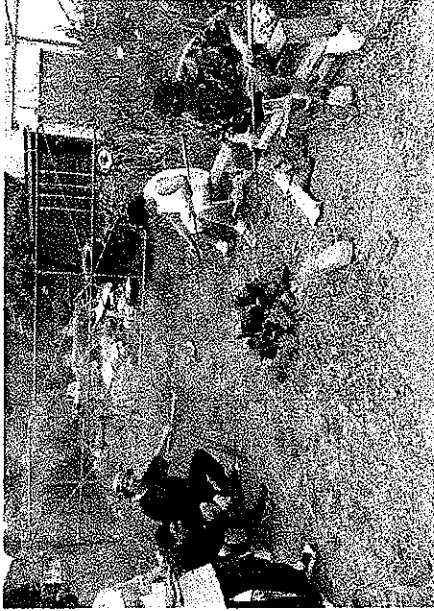
### **Legitimate Graphic Design after-school programme 09**

7 students - A combination of police and community referrals and direct requests from students themselves as a reward. Pic 1 – Police Referral. His label is Animal Instinct. Pic 2 – Paihia Christmas Parade Banner. These kids were gifted t-shirts to produce more labelled apparel. As one of our community projects we produced labelled t-shirts for a local dance group of 30 mums - 'Mama Shakers' and a logo for St John's Junior Cadets.



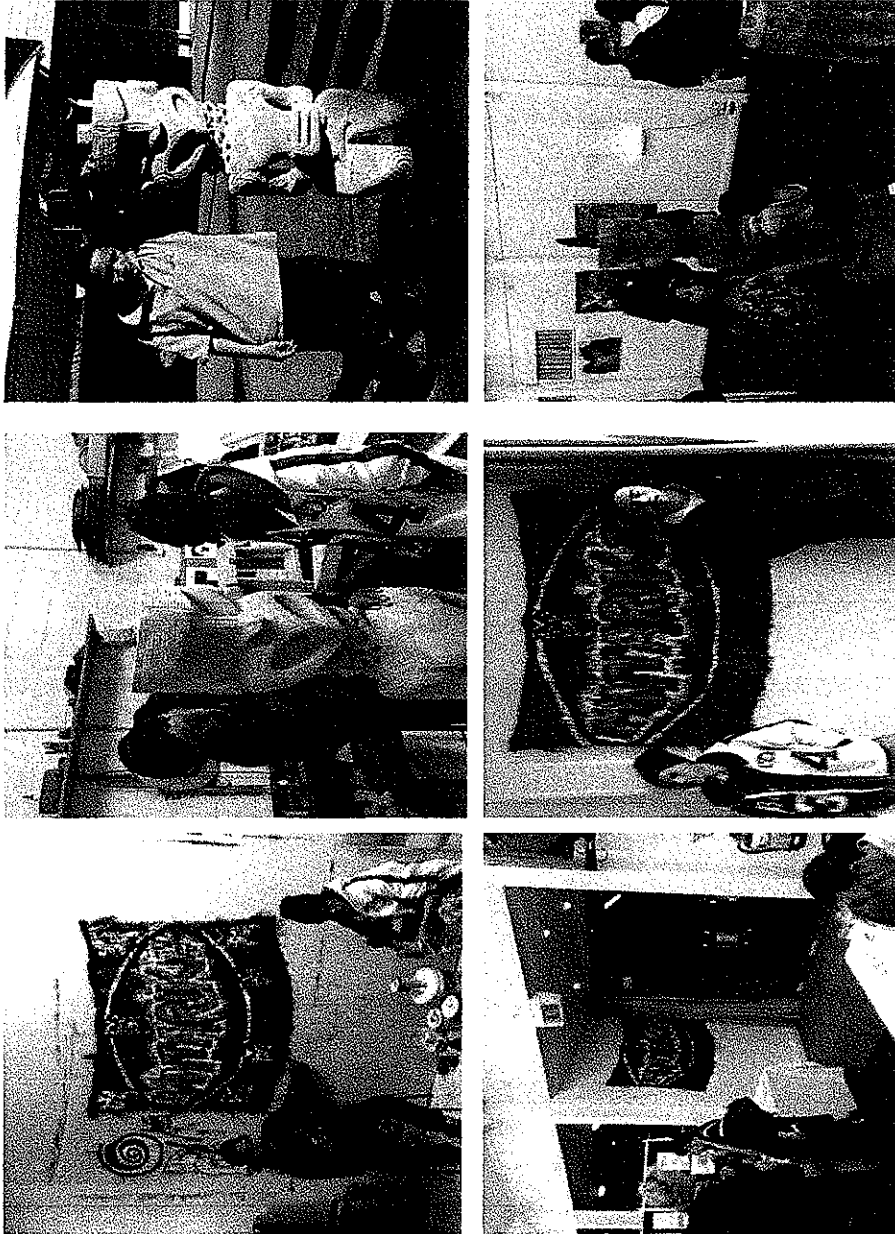
### **Legitimate graphic design afterschool programme 2010**

Same combination of referrals from police, schools and community. Kids from Bay of Islands College, Moerewa School and Motatau School. Labels being produced include Waewae Express and Fusion. Current community project is for Kawakawa Playcentre.



## **Legitimate and Moerewa Alternative education project Community and self respect programme**

Reconnecting at-risk youth, the environment and their community. Alternative education programme 'Ko Tahī Tātou Trust' approached Legitimate head tutor to facilitate a workshop based around a traditional weapon – the taiaha. A 4-week workshop took place November 2009 covering a variety of social issues. According to police, the kids on this programme were '90% of the vandalism problem around Kawakawa and Moerewa'. Some taiaha produced in this workshop are currently exhibiting at Waka Huia Treasure Trove & Studio. One taiaha gifted to Tohe Ashby, Chairman of Ngati Hine. An exhibition is currently being curated to show all the taiaha, photos and lessons learnt at Waka Huia. Pic 3 – Vincent Mahana won 'Best Student' prize of whalebone taonga gifted by Legitimate.



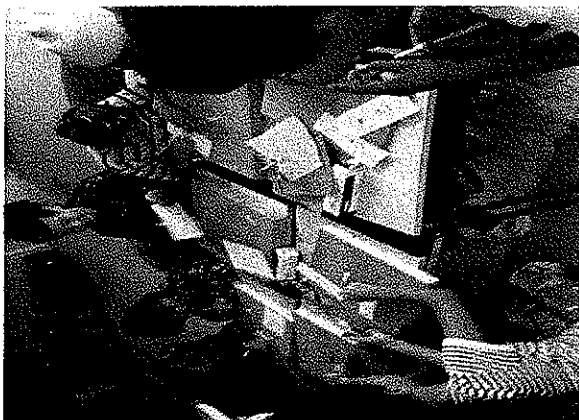
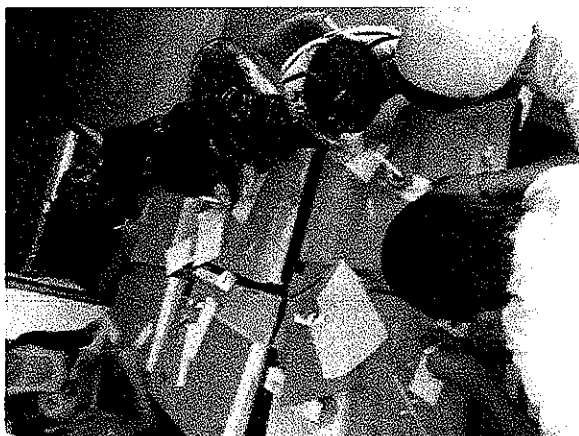
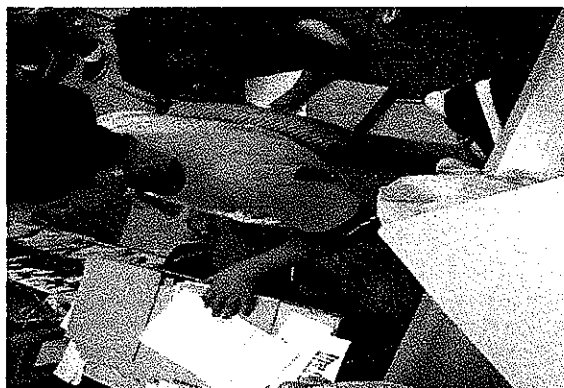
### **Legitimate Exhibition project Waitangi Matariki 09 Corpthorne hotel**

Hand-chosen students were chosen to assist tutor Charlie Kopa and Wiremu Wilson-Diamond to produce works for a Matariki Exhibition. Boys referred by the police produced the Matariki Cloak design and also assisted with finishing of carvign in images 2 & 3. As part of the Matariki Programme we also did a live 'bombling' demo – a mural based around Matariki. The two top students from the Moerewa School Legitimate class were chosen to assist.



## Removal processes 2010

This year our main removal area has been the local milk depot and certain periods of the year eg holidays where there is more passing traffic (pic 4). The 3 public areas where we have produced bombings and murals are still untouched.



## **Motatao school and Legitimate programme**

6 Motatao students are brought to the Legitimate Programme every Wednesday and are currently producing air-brushed labelled apparel. Some student labels being produced are Lo-trim (addressing social issue of obesity); Stepoff (anti-bullying); Little Miss Motatao (celebrating strong women)
