Distress, urgency and calls

All emergency calls – VHF channel 16 or cell phone *500.

MAYDAY: use if a vessel, aircraft or person is in grave and imminent danger and requires immediate assistance.

PAN PAN: use to indicate that a vessel has a very urgent message to transmit about its safety, such as loss of steering.

Note: when MAYDAY is not warranted but urgency is required for the safety of a vessel or person, PAN PAN should be used. Calls and messages must be cancelled if assistance is no longer required or when the incident is over.

Other ways to signal distress

- Slowly and repeatedly raise and lower your arms outstretched to each side.
- Continuously sound a fog horn or siren.
- Use a hand-held flare or parachute flare showing a red light.
- Signal SOS by any signal method, including sound, light, or mirror. The SOS signal is: three shorts, three longs, three shorts.

Use these signals only to indicate distress.
See back cover for correct radio protocol
when making a distress call.

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Prep | Check | Know

Prepare your boat

- Service the engine regularly.
- Check the hull for damage.
- Ensure the bilges are clean and dry.
- Check and test batteries.
- Test steering.
- Check that electrical equipment and navigation lights work.
- Ensure the bung is in.

Check the weather forecast and your gear

Checking the weather before you head out on the water is essential to prepare for a safe trip.

If in doubt, don't go out!

Equipment checklist

Life jackets – suitably sized for each person on board.

If you are on a vessel six metres and under, you must wear your life jacket when you're underway and if there is heightened risk.

Fuel – have a third to get there, a third to return and a third in reserve.

Communication devices – take at least two appropriate means of communication (see next page for more information).

Navigation – chart, GPS, plotter, depth sounder and navigation lights.

Anchor – suitable for vessel with chain and non-floating rope.

Bailing system – bucket, bailer or bilge pump.

Fire extinguisher – store in an appropriate case.

First aid kit – for minor accidents or injuries.

Torch – with spare batteries.

Throw line – in case of person overboard.

Alternative means of propulsion – oars or spare engine.

Make sure all passengers know what safety gear is on board, where it's stored, and how to use it.

Communications

Always carry a minimum of two forms of communication that will work in the area where you will be boating. Appropriate means of communication should:

- Provide the ability to communicate with land based and/or seaborne parties from any point within the area the vessel will be operated; and
- in the case of a vessel 6 metres or less in length, at least one form should be able to be operated following submersion in sea water (for example - a mobile phone in a waterproof lanyard bag); and
- have sufficient coverage and power to operate for the actual duration of the voyage.



Marine VHF radio

VHF radios are designed to get you help when things are going wrong. When there's reception they are the most reliable way to call for help, as by calling 'mayday' on Channel 16 you are communicating with a wider audience and vessels which are more likely to be able to give immediate assistance. Check the marine and Coastguard radio frequencies on page 6-7 of this book.

Distress beacons

Set your beacon off in an emergency - it's the most effective way of letting people know that you need urgent help and where to find you. It's important to check its battery life regularly.



Cellphone

Cell phones are generally only helpful if kept dry and when you are close to land. Keep yours in a sealed waterproof bag, in a secure location. Save the battery for essential communication. You can call 111 if in distress. Be aware that you may not have cell phone coverage so always take another form of communication. **And remember to charge it!**

Flares and torches

Flares are visual signals that grab attention over long distances. When waved torches can be effective too.



Whistles, Horns, Mirrors etc.

There are a range of other signalling devices that can be used for communication, including a whistle, manual horn (aerosol canister, rechargeable, powered), mirror etc. Like flares, they are reliant on someone being able to see or hear the distress signal, knowing what it means, and then being able to act on it.





Know the rules

The skipper is responsible for the safety of the vessel and passengers.

You must be aged over 15 to operate a vessel capable of going 10 knots or more.

Plan your safe route before departure and make sure someone on shore knows your plans.

Use your VHF radio to file a trip report with your local Coastguard or private radio station stating:

- name of vessel.
- where you are going.
- how many people are on board.
- when you expect to return.
- close your trip report once you have returned safely.

Failing to close a trip report with Maritime Radio is unlikely to spark a rescue. Telling someone where you are going and when they should call Police on 111 if you don't return is key.

Keep to the speed limit – all boats must go 5 knots (9.25 km/h) or less:

- within 50m of people in the water and other vessels or structures.
- within 200m of a boat or buoy/float flying a dive flag and within 200m of the shore.

Keep a good look out and have an additional person observing when towing.

Don't overload your vessel.

Don't drink alcohol and go boating.

Watch your wake

Under local rules, skippers need to ensure that wake doesn't put other vessels, structures, or people at risk. Please be respectful of others and operate your craft accordingly. If you own a large vessel with twin engines, you can reduce your wake and speed by:

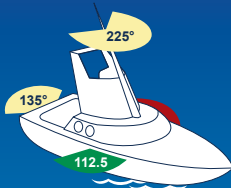
- stopping when you enter a 5 knot area;
- running on one engine;
- taking them in and out of gear

Lights

Your boat must display lights from sunset to sunrise and in rain and fog to help other boats know which way you're heading. Not using lights could result in a fine.

Powerboats over 12m

Need to display a masthead light, sidelights and stern lights.



Powerboats under 12m

May show all-round white light (instead of masthead light and sternlight) + sidelights.



Anchor light

Every boat at anchor must show only a white light that is visible from all directions between sunset and sunrise.

Dinghies and kayaks under 7m non-powered

Must show a white light or torch.

Power boats UNDER 7m and not capable of speeds over 7 knots

Need only display an all-round white light.

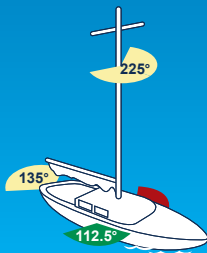


Sailing boats motoring or motor-sailing

Are considered to be powerboats and must display sidelights, a sternlight and a masthead light.

Masthead light

Masthead lights shine forward in a 225 degree arc and must be at least 1m above the sidelights.



Watch out for ships

Large ships need plenty of manoeuvring room and cannot stop easily. Bay of Islands and Whangārei harbours are busy and require extra vigilance.

- Don't cross the bow of manoeuvring ships.
- Within Northland harbours, all boats are required to keep well clear of and give way to ships over 500gt (gross tonnes)(and seaplanes taking off or landing).
- Cruise ships entering and leaving the Bay of Islands take the same route through the bay – be sure to keep clear of ships moving through the bay and do not anchor in the Waitangi sector light.
- Keep a look out early morning and late afternoon when cruise ships normally transit.

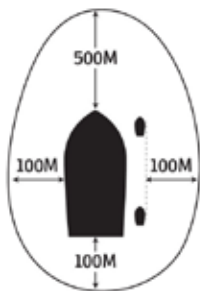

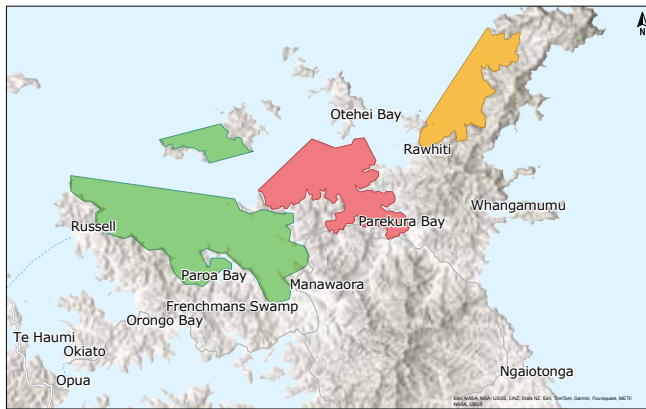


Areas to avoid

Channel Terminal Services prohibited area and Northport exclusion zone:

- There is a permanent prohibited area around the Channel Terminal Services (shown on chart NZ 5214).
- When the exclusion zone is in force, fluorescent 'Keep clear' signs (by day) and flashing lights (by night) are displayed on the seaward side of the ship.
- Keep clear of the shipping channel when vessels over 500gt are transiting.
- Do not anchor in the channel.

New marine protected areas

New rāhui tapu marine protected areas are in place in Northland.

These areas have been introduced to protect local marine ecosystems severely impacted by fishing.

Fishing and collecting kai moana (seafood) is no longer allowed:

- around the Mimiwhangata peninsula
- from Maunganui Bay (Deep Water Cove) to Opourua (Oke Bay) in the Bay of Islands.

In a third area, around Cape Brett, bulk harvesting of fish using commercial seining and trawling methods is prohibited to a depth of 100 metres.

Exceptions to the no-take rules include kina harvesting, research or restoration activities, and non-commercial customary fishing rights guaranteed under Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

STOP exotic Caulerpa seaweed

Exotic caulerpa is a fast-growing seaweed that threatens our native marine ecosystem. It has been found in parts of the Bay of Islands, including Te Rāwhiti Inlet, where there are legal restrictions in place.

To help stop it from spreading:

- Check for seaweed on your anchor, chain and gear before you move to a new location.
- Remove any seaweed you find, bag it securely and dispose of it onshore in the rubbish.
- If you can't bag it securely, return it to the water where it was found.

Steer clear of the wave buoys

All vessels are required to stay at least 100 metres clear of the wave rider buoys. Vessels in the Whangārei approaches should not enter or leave the channel between Fairway Buoy and No. 1 Buoy.

Please do not approach or fish near the buoys as they are mounted with numerous delicate instruments that can be easily damaged.



Mooring piracy

There are many designated mooring areas in Northland. All moorings are held by individual licence holders. The mooring licence is vessel specific and subject to compliance with the Northland Navigation Safety Bylaw. Under the Northland Navigation Safety Bylaw, it is an offence to secure any vessel to a mooring without the licence holders' permission and can incur a \$200 infringement fee.

When anchoring

- Anchor carefully and ensure your boat doesn't drag or swing around and damage other craft. Check your swing room is sufficient for the anchor scope (length of anchor warp).
- Ensure you have enough anchor line out to cover the tidal range and stream. It is recommended to use at least three to five times the depth in calm conditions – additional length will be necessary in higher winds.
- Choose an anchorage clear of busy channels, marina and bay entrances, and mooring fields.
- Check your chart for prohibited anchorages and avoid areas of underwater cables.
- Visibly display your contact name and phone number/email address in case of emergency.

Crossing bars

Northland has multiple bar harbours. These have a shallow sand bar across the harbour entrance which can be dangerous to cross, particularly during low tide.

Before crossing:

- Check weather and tides for the area and seek advice from locals.
- Check your steering and engines.
- Consider the skipper's experience level and the vessel type.
- A rapid change in conditions may prevent a safe return to harbour – if your vessel and provision levels won't allow you to weather it out at sea, don't leave port.

During a bar crossing:

- Securely batten down or close all deck openings, hatches and doors.
- Ensure your vessel has adequate stability. Secure moveable objects and ensure all weights, including passengers, are as low down in the vessel as possible.
- Ensure everyone on board is awake, dressed and wearing their lifejacket.
- Approach the bar at a moderate speed so you can adjust your speed as needed.
- Have a lookout at the back of the boat to watch for dangerous building swells.



Diving and dive flags

You must fly a dive flag if you are:

- Diving from a vessel or diving unaccompanied from the shore.
- In an area where there may be passing vessels.

You must stay within 200m of a clearly displayed flag which may be:

- On a vessel – 600mm x 600mm.
- On a buoy or float attached to diver with a dive flag – 200mm x 200mm.

If you are approaching a vessel flying a dive flag slow down to below 5 knots when within 200 metres and look out for bubbles indicating a diver below.



Remember to fly your flag high so it can be seen.

Waste disposal

Rubbish barge

The rubbish barge service operates in the Bay of Islands during peak season (usually from around Boxing Day to mid-January).

During this period, dates, times and location of the barge are broadcasted by Russell Radio VHF channel 63 every day.

Sewage

There are strict rules covering sewage discharges from boats in Northland waters – these apply to every type of boat or craft.

Oil/fuel spills

Preventing spills

- Check the engine for leaks and clean up any fuel or oil in the bilge.
- Consider installing a bilge water filter.
- Never mix detergent with oily bilge water before pumping as most detergents are also contaminants.
- Always keep pieces of sorbent material under your engine and handy to clean up spills.
- Stop water leaking into your boat to reduce the number of times bilges need to be pumped out.

Fuelling (Bunkering) your vessel

- Estimate the amount of fuel needed before starting.
- Plug the scuppers with rags.
- Whenever possible, refuel using a fuel pump. Only use containers to transfer fuel to your boat when there is no alternative.
- Ensure your engine room bilge isn't set to automatic.

Cleaning up spills

Any oil or fuel spills from your vessel should be cleaned up with special sorbent material, which can be bought from boat chandlers and marine suppliers. Small pads soak up large amounts of oil/fuel and cannot be reused. Dispose of oily pads to landfill. Any oil/fuel should be disposed of by a specialist waste management company or at a waste oil reception facility at marinas.

Tide table instructions

New Zealand daylight saving time

The tide predictions for the Standard (main) ports in this tide table have been corrected for daylight saving time. Daylight savings runs from 2am Sunday 28 September 2025 to 3am Sunday 5 April 2026.

Standard ports

All New Zealand tidal data is referenced to predictions for standard (main) ports. Northland's standard ports are Marsden Point on the east coast and Port Taranaki on the west coast.
