

### What the current plans say

Implementation	Assessment
<b>Consultation</b> – "encourages applicants to consult with tangata whenua over development proposals within the coastal marine area"	
<b>Decision Making</b> – "Provide for a tangata whenua representative in taiapure and maataitai reserves and waters classified for cultural purposes"	
<b>Advice and Information sharing</b> – "Provide advice and information to tangata whenua"	
<b>Monitoring</b> – "commits to investigating options for tangata whenua involvement in monitoring"	
<b>Iwi/ Hapu Management Plans</b> – "that the council will assist in the development of iwi management plans for resources within their rohe"


