

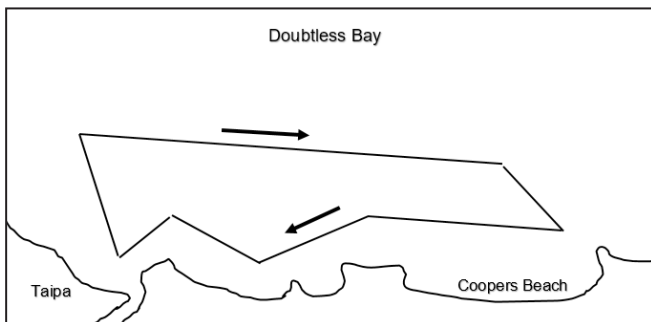
AREA RESERVED FOR POWER BOAT RACING

TAIPA, DOUBTLESS BAY

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Clause 3.9 of the Northland Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2017, the following area will be reserved to enable the NZ Power Boat Association to carry out a racing event.

Saturday 07 April 2018, between the hours of 11.00pm and 1.30pm.

An area extending approximately 300mts from the shoreline of Taipa Beach, Cable Bay and across to Rangikapiti Point at the eastern end of Coopers Beach and extending approximately 1 kilometre out into Doubtless Bay. See plan.



Marshalling vessels will redirect all non-competing vessels on a route around the top and approximately 200 metres outside the race course during the above reserved times. Spectator vessels are prohibited from entering the reserved area inside the course and the prohibited area around Cable Bay.

The reserved area will be clearly marked with flags and buoys throughout the event. All non-participating persons are requested to keep clear of the reserved areas at all times during the event and to navigate with caution when in the vicinity of the course area.

During this event, sub clause 3.2.1(a) & (b) governing the speed and navigation of participating vessels will be suspended. Participating vessels will be allowed to exceed 5 knots within 200 metres of shore and within 50 metres of another vessel while competing within the reserved area.
