Tena koe Alyssa,

Very briefly three comments:

(a) Very grateful for the consent being only for three years.

(b) Discharge to water (21) by leaching from pond to stream should not be tolerated; sealing the pond is possible and should be done.

(c) In order for the CLG to exist meaningfully it must be constituted by the community rather than the Council. Once it is formed, which I believe is the intention of many or most of the submitters, it should determine the character of its relationship to Council. It should meet regularly with council staff; it should determine the terms of the relationship so that it drives the process; it should work alongside the contract-holders for the implementation of the improvements Council has agreed to make; it should be active in choosing the treatment protocols and it should engage with landholders and neighbours.

By setting and circumstances the CLG should be hapu-led, it should include representatives of the committees, and it should invite participation of the statutory agencies relevant (i.e. nga runanga).
