Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Clause 3.10 of the Northland Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2012, the following area will be reserved to enable the NZ Power Boat Association to carry out a racing event.

**Saturday 9 May 2015, between the hours of
11.00am and 2.00pm.**

An area, from the Waitangi Bridge across Te Ti Bay to Nihinui Point, to the outside of Motumaire Island, north towards a position midway between Motumaire Island and Russell, to Brampton Buoy and southwest to Manawaora Bay.

The reserved area will be clearly marked with flags and buoys and patrolled throughout the event. All non-participating persons are requested to keep clear of the reserved area at all times during the event and to navigate with caution when in the vicinity of the reserved area.

During this event, sub clause 3.2.1(a) and (b) governing the speed and navigation of participating vessels will be suspended. Participating vessels will be allowed to exceed 5 knots within 200 metres of shore and within 50 metres of another vessel while competing within the reserved area.
