AHIPARA AND NINETY MILE BEACH

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Clause 3.13.3 of the Northland Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2012, that the following areas will be reserved to enable the Thundercat Racing Association of New Zealand Inc. to carry out racing events on **Saturday, 6 February 2016, between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm:**

- A 500 metre long area adjacent to the beach access ramp at Ahipara Beach
- A 50 metre long area adjacent to the beach south of Hukatere access, Ninety Mile Beach
- A 50 metre long area adjacent to the beach south of The Bluff, Ninety Mile Beach
- A 100 metre long area adjacent to the beach south of Scott Point, Ninety Mile Beach.

The reserved areas will be clearly marked with flags and/or buoys throughout the event. All non-participating persons are requested to keep clear of the reserved areas at all times during the event and navigate with caution when in the vicinity of these areas.

During this event, sub clause 3.2.1(a) & (b) governing the speed and navigation of participating vessels will be suspended. Participating vessels will be allowed to exceed 5 knots within 200 metres of the shore inside the four reserved areas.
