AREA RESERVED FOR BATH TUB BOAT RACING

WAITANGI AND PAIHIA,
BAY OF ISLANDS HARBOUR



Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Clause 3.13 of the Northland Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2012, the following area will be reserved to enable Far North Holdings Limited to carry out a racing event.

Saturday, 16 April 2016, between the hours of 10.00am and 3.00pm.

An area of Te Ti Bay Beach adjacent to Nihinui Point for course racing and secondly, an area from Te Ti Beach to the outside of Motumaire Island following a circumnavigation of Motumaire Island and return to Te Ti Beach. The races will be held in an area within the reserved period for racing of the NZ Offshore Power Boat Association races.

The reserved areas will be clearly marked with flags and buoys and patrolled throughout the event. All non-participating persons are requested to keep clear of the reserved area at all times during the event and to navigate with caution when in the vicinity of the reserved area.

During this event, sub clause 3.2.1(a) and (b) governing the speed and navigation of participating vessels will be suspended. Participating vessels will be allowed to exceed 5 knots within 200 metres of shore and within 50 metres of another vessel while competing within the reserved area.
