



## KAURI DIEBACK AERIAL SURVEY

The annual aerial survey to identify dead or dying kauri trees, in order to manage and prevent the spread of Kauri Dieback in Northland and for land management purposes, is planned for the following areas between December 2017 and March 2018:

- Aupōuri peninsula
- Kaitāia area
- Whangārei
- Southern Northland
- Poutō peninsula

The regional council will contact you if there are any concerns about the health of kauri trees on your property. Individual properties will not be publicly identified as a result of this work.
