

Hi Alister

1. This email is further to the request for clarification made by the Commissioner in the email dated 28 September 2020.

Public berthing

- 2. Based on my reading of your email to the Commissioner entitled "FW: Response re APP.041365.01.01 DC Schmuck & Interesting Projects Ltd" (the version I have does not have a date), your understanding of what is proposed in respect to public berthing is correct.
- 3. To summarise, the proposal (as set out in paragraph 2 of my final planning right of reply) is to enable the berthing of public vessels at the marina pontoon (not confined to the eastern end) when it is vacant and also elsewhere within the Marina Mooring Area Boundary (see exhibit from the referenced Total Marine Plan below). All of this is subject to prior arrangement, compliance with the access restrictions through the security gate, and in accordance with the proposed restrictions in (a)-(e) of the proposed condition.



4. For clarity, Mr Schmuck's letter (referenced by the Commissioner) has been superseded by the proposed condition outlined in my planning right of reply, in so far as public berthing is concerned.

Plans

- 5. There are several plans prepared by several companies which make up the suite of plans to be attached to the consent. These include plans prepared by Reyburn and Bryant, Total Marine, Vision Consulting, and Thompson Survey. Aligning these plans (and companies) has been difficult, as often a change to one plan results in a change to another. However, only the Reyburn and Bryant and Total Marine plans have been amended from those included in the s42A report.
- 6. The only amendment to the Reyburn and Bryant plans is the deletion of the turntable which has been removed from the site.
- 7. Unfortunately, the Total Marine plans included in the s42A report were not the most recent plans. These plans had been updated and sent to the Northland Regional Council on 29/06/2020, but for some reason they were omitted.
- 8. The differences between the plans in the s42A report and those sent to the Council on 29/06/20 (and now included in the final suite of plans) are as follows:

- a. Legal descriptions updated on APP-039650-01-01 Sheet 0005 (previously these were incorrect).
- b. Fender piles added for protection of gangway on APP-039650-01-01 Sheet 0001.
- c. Beach grids added to the working berths for clarity on APP-039650-01-01 Sheet 0001. Note that beach grids are not structures. They are the part of a working berth above the low tide mark (post dredging).
- d. Gangway handrail detail added to APP-039650-01-01 Sheet 0002.
- 9. For clarity, a full and final suite of plans is **attached**. These will need to be stamped by the NRC if they have not been already.
- 10. Finally, please pass on my apology to the Commissioner regarding his confusion around plans and public berthing. The applicant has been trying extremely hard to strike a delicate balance between providing for public berthing without compromising the primary purpose of the structures.
