- ii. Ms McGuire to provide confirmation of the mechanism enabling the Kaipara District Council dog control bylaw to apply to the Coastal Marine Area, including the foreshore area surrounding the application site:

As shown in the attached correspondence from Mark Schreurs of Kaipara District Council (KDC) the Kaipara District Policy on Dogs and Dog Management Bylaw applies to any area not part of a private title down to mean low water springs therefore includes the foreshore area surrounding the application site. KDC is able to enforce this bylaw within this area under the Local Government Act 2002 (LGA) as the foreshore is included in the boundaries of the Kaipara District. The seaward boundaries of districts listed under Schedule 1 of the LGA (including Kaipara District) were extended in 2011 down to mean low water springs. Please see the below link to the Local Government Boundary Alteration Notice 2011.

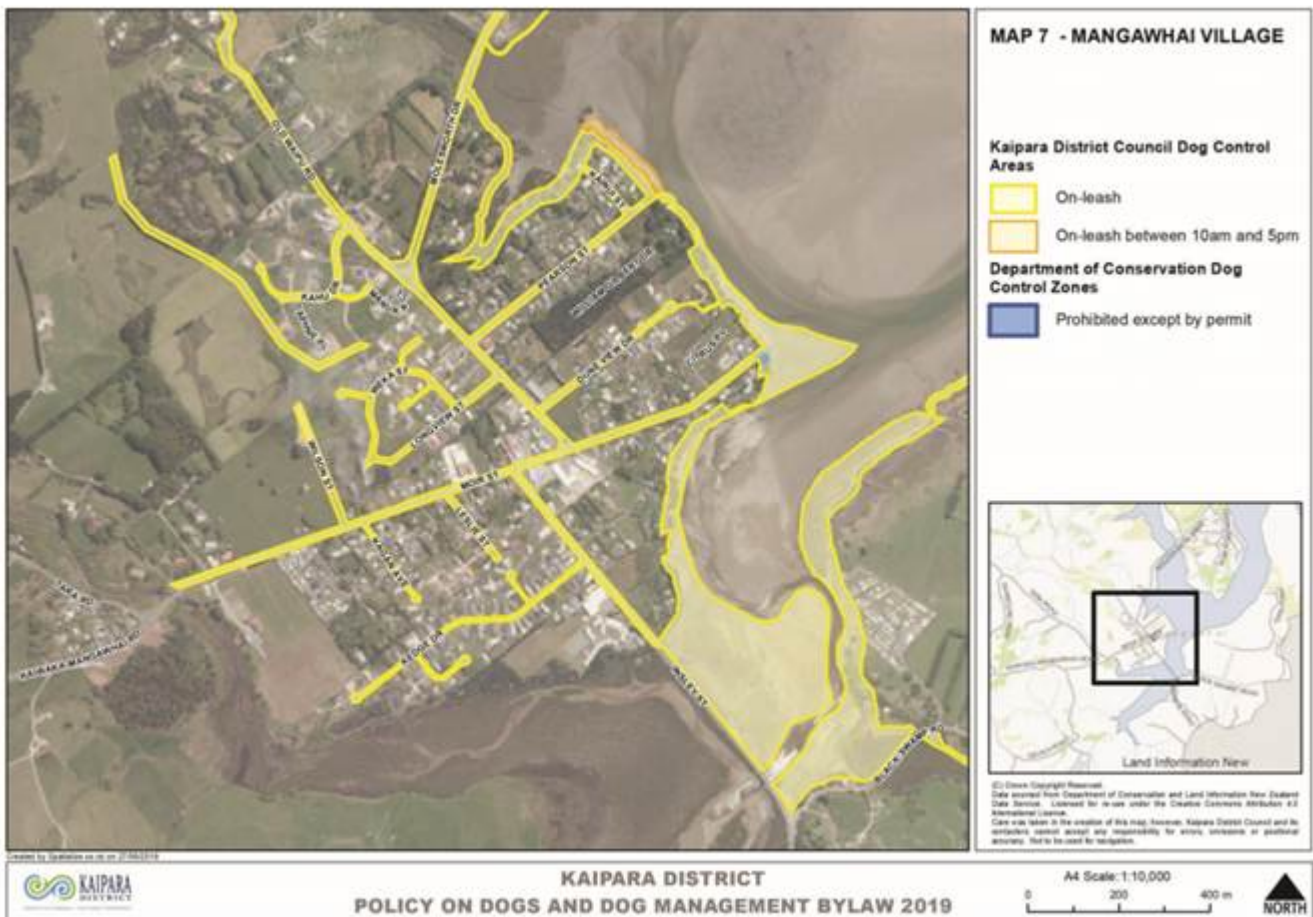
