



NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION FOR RESOURCE CONSENT UNDER THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991

Northland Regional Council has received applications from Far North District Council for resource consents.

The applications seek to renew the resource consents for the continued operation of the Kaitāia Wastewater Treatment Plant that services the township of Kaitāia and the adjacent sludge storage facility.

The resource consents being applied for are:

Kaitāia Wastewater Treatment Plant:

1. The discharge of treated wastewater to the Awanui River.
2. The discharge of contaminants (primarily odour) to air from the wastewater treatment plant.
3. The discharge of treated wastewater to land via seepage from the wastewater treatment plant.

Sludge storage facility:

1. Discharge contaminants to land by way of seepage from the base of the sludge storage facility.
2. Discharge contaminants to air (primarily odour) from the sludge storage facility.
