





LOVE OPUA CHARITABLE TRUST

TRUST DEED

This Deed is made the 20 day of October 2014.

PARTIES

BRIAN BERNARD HEPBURN, Insurance Agent of Opua
MANUELA GMUER Company Director of Opua
PATRICIA MARIE SHARP, Bar Manager of Opua
FRANK WILLIAM LEADLEY Retired School Principal of Opua
BRETT ETHERTON, Sales Assistant of Opua
(*First Trustees*)

BACKGROUND

- A. The First Trustees wish to establish a Charitable Trust ("the Trust") for the objects described in clause 4 of this Deed and have agreed to enter into this Deed specifying the purposes of the Trust and providing for its control and governance.
- B. It is intended that the Trust will be registered as a Charitable Trust pursuant to Charitable Trusts Act 1957.

OPERATIVE PART

1. Name:

The name of the Trust shall be "LOVE OPUA CHARITABLE TRUST".


2. Definitions and Interpretations:

Trust Fund means the sum of ten dollars gifted to the Trustees to establish the Trust together with any other monies shares or property paid to, purchased by or transferred to the Trustees and all money and investments from time to time representing the same.

The Board shall mean the Board of Trustees appointed pursuant to clause 7 of this Deed. Members of the Trust are persons who have become and remain members pursuant to clause 1 of this Deed.

3. Office:

The office of the Trust shall be at such place in Opua as the Board may determine.



4. Objects:

The objects of the Trust are:

- 4.1. To provide care and support for needy, disadvantaged, aged or infirm residents of the Opua area
- 4.2. To create parks and reserves for the recreation, enjoyment and wellbeing of the residents of the Opua area
- 4.3. To promote education about indigenous flora and fauna through community involvement in creating and maintaining parks and reserves within the Opua area.
- 4.4. To establish and support Neighbourhood Watch for the safety and security of the residents of the Opua area
- 4.5. To raise and provide funding to any public or charitable body to assist in all and any of the above objects.

5. Residents of Opua:

In pursuing its purposes the Trust shall recognise the views and expectations of the local residents and will as and when necessary consult with appropriate residents of Opua.

6. Structure

- 6.1. The Trustees shall hold the Trust Fund and apply the same in accordance with the Objects set out in clause 4.
- 6.2. The Trust shall be administered by the Board.

7. The Board:

7.1 Numbers:

The Board shall consist of not fewer than three or more than seven Trustees. Trustees other than the First Trustees are to be appointed by the Board, by majority decision if there is disagreement. In event of equality of Trustees as to appointment or non-appointment of a nominee, that nominee will not be appointed.

9.2

The Board will have the following powers:

- a) to raise money by donation, subscription or otherwise and to pay and apply the same whether directly or through other bodies under clause 4.5 in furtherance of the objects of the Trust.
- b) to purchase, lease, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property.
- c) to sell, let, mortgage or otherwise dispose or deal with any of the property of the Board.
- d) to construct, maintain or alter any buildings or property.
- e) to borrow, invest or loan money in any manner and on any terms suitable to the Board.
- f) to enter into any arrangement or contract with any individual, government department or corporate body.
- g) to pay all or any of the expenses in establishing and running the Board.
- h) to employ or engage staff, advisers or other people whether or not they are Trustees and to pay their wages, salaries and or their expenses on terms suitable to the Board.
- i) to alter the powers and rules of the Board provided that no alteration or addition endangers the charitable aims and status of the Board.
- j) to do anything else that in the opinion of the Board will further the charitable aims of the Board.

10. Board Meetings:

10.1

The Board will hold at least four meetings in every year and one of these meetings will be the Annual General Meeting which is to be held not more than fifteen months following the previous Annual General Meeting.

10.2

At the first meeting of the Board and at every Annual General Meeting the Board will appoint the following officers:

- a) a Chairman, who will be responsible for convening and chairing the Board meetings.
- b) a Secretary who will carry out the functions allocated to the Secretary in these rules.
- c) a Treasurer who will record the finance transactions of the Board.
